ODESIA'S 2006 REVENUES INCREASE BY 57%

MONTREAL, May 1st 2007 - Odesia Group Inc. ("ODESIA") (TSX-V ODS) is pleased to announce year-over-year growth in revenues of 57% in 2006 compared to the 12-month period ending May 31 2005.

"We achieved a record year in 2006, having served more than 20 organizations of international calibre in Canada and in Europe. By year-end 2006, we had doubled the number of professional consultants working for ODESIA to 85," said Mr. Nicolas Bonnafous, President and Chief Executive Officer of ODESIA.

Following the acquisition in March 2006 of what is now ODESIA's French subsidiary, Odesia Europe SAS, headquartered in Paris, the Company's financial results showed robust growth. Clients such as Canal + in France and SITA in Switzerland were among the first to show their confidence in ODESIA in Europe. In Canada, ODESIA continues to serve Yellow Pages, Aeroplan and National Bank amongst its main clients.

Key financial facts for 2006 and the Company's outlook:

- A 57% growth in revenues to \$7,999,764, from \$5,089,328 during the 12-month period ending May 31, 2005.
- The rapid development of the Paris office, getting our new organization under way, and costs related to our first year as a publicly listed company incurred major expenses. Therefore, costs of supplying services, operating and administrative expenses amounted to \$7,793,528 in 2006 compared to \$4,653,759 for the 12-month period ended 31 May 2005.
- A net profit of \$80,763 was reported for 2006, compared to a net profit of \$219,656 for the 12-month period ended 31 May 2005. Although the net profit decreased year-over-year, it is clear that the Company experienced strong organic growth during 2006 and that this should be reflected in increased net profits in 2007.

ODESIA foresees continued strong growth in 2007, given the Company's ability to export its expertise and establish branches in untapped markets. The Company is currently signing new clients in Canada and Europe, while expanding its full-time staff of professionals. The ODESIA team's experience and skills in designing Business Intelligence solutions directly

contribute to the decision-making and strategic vision of the large and medium-sized companies that comprise Odesia's clientele.
