ODESIA ACQUIRES RESOURCE IT
Combines BI services with IT solutions in fast-growing economy

MONTREAL, CANADA AND QUERÉTARO, MEXICO, December 3, 2007 - Odesia Group Inc. ("ODESIA") (TSX-V ODS) has completed the closing of the transaction announced on November 1, 2007 under which ODESIA has acquired a group of companies comprised of Resource IT de Mexico, Resource IT Software de México, and Global Business Integration de Mexico (collectively, "**Resource IT**"), for a total purchase price of \$2 million Canadian dollars.

Resource IT now becomes a wholly-owned subsidiary of ODESIA. Current management remains in place and will play a key role in expanding ODESIA's activities in Mexico. This transaction adds 70 new consultants to the existing group, now providing Business Intelligence solutions and IT services in France, Canada, and Mexico.

"We are excited about the opportunities the combined companies will create in this fast-growing Mexican economy. We plan to take advantage of a number of revenue synergies by expanding market opportunities, and believe we can gain a larger share of the rapidly growing BI segment while generating increased margins" said Nicolas Bonnafous, President and CEO of ODESIA.

"ODESIA shares our passion and complements our strengths: technology leadership and customer focused innovation. Bringing both companies together will allow us to transcend what we have accomplished as individual businesses and expand the Business Intelligence solutions in Latin America" added Alfredo Pina of Resource IT.

The acquisition of Resource IT is summarized as follows:

- \$1,000,000 in cash, of which \$125,000 paid on closing and the balance payable in quarterly instalments from March 31, 2008 to December 31, 2010, bearing 12% interest rate;
- Issuance of 2,222,222 common shares of ODESIA at a price of \$0.45 per share. The issued shares will be held in escrow and released semi-annually until November 29, 2009. The issuance of shares has been conditionally approved by the TSX-V;
- The vendors can also be entitled to earn-out payments of approximately \$672,000 over the next two years if they deliver annual revenues of more than 36,842,105 Mxn Pesos, (approximately \$3,500,000).
